

At this juncture, unconsciously we enter the domain of psychology, which is a dominant part of ourselves. Psychology comes from the psyche. Our value package comes from the psyche. They both bulge out of the psyche in various sequences of hierarchical orders. When we try to find our own values, we compare ourselves to others. We cast projections. We broadcast intentions and our real values get lost in the values of others. What will others think when we try to push our own values? This is a thought based on fear and fear comes from losing self-confidence. Our values do not depend upon anybody else's reactions. This value package is an unconditional endowment from the principle of creation. It is a personal gift. It differs from person to person, depending upon worthiness and adequacy, perseverance and sensitivity.

Self-confidence is the only antidote for fear and weakness. Self-confidence is an outcome of simplicity and highest sense of moral rectitude. Fear and weakness hide the truth and if we hide the truth we hide our own values.
